



Storm Preparation

Step 1:

With a philips screwdriver, remove the motor box covers. Release the quick disconnect hydraulic hoses and unplug the wire harness. Lift motors out and store in safe place.

Step 2:

With the philips screwdriver and a 7/16th wrench, remove the control box and store in a safe place until the storm passes.

Post Storm Instructions

Before replacing the motors and control box make sure that you have “clean” power. We highly recommend that you have a licensed electrician inspect the wiring from the electrical panel all the way to the lift to ensure there is no electrical problems.

Step 1:

Remove all CHU covers and visually inspect all cables and pulleys for damage.

Step 2:

Completely rinse out the inside of the CHU's and all cables and pulleys with fresh water to remove all salt water. Let dry.

Step 3:

Using a marine grade spray lubricant, liberally coat all cables, cylinders, pulleys, and fittings to prevent corrosion.

Step 4: Replace motors and control box and run the lift **without your**

boat on the lift. Run the lift up and down several times to make sure it runs smoothly and quietly. If you suspect anything is wrong call us before placing your boat on lift.
